Review of August Meeting Notes and P&R Department August Monthly Report

Old Business:

Discussed the idea of the Blomstrom Consulting Network again. Karen will discuss with Dan about the idea of using resources provided by Blomstrom Consulting in acquiring sponsorships for community events during department budget talks. Will keep the committee posted.
