**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LIMERICK TOWNSHIP  
AMENDING A POLICY CONCERNING THE INSPECTION AND COPYING OF  
RECORDS BY THE TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, on September 15, 1998, the Board of Supervisors of Limerick Township (the "Township") adopted Resolution No. 98-18, guaranteeing residents of the Township access to public records under the Right-to-Know Law of June 21, 1957, P.L. 390, No. 2, and establishing the procedure by which the Township would address requests made to it for records under the 1957 Right-to-Know Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution and Right-to-Know Policy in order to fully comply with the Right-to-Know Act of February 14, 2008, (the "Act"); and


**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is adopted in order to assure availability of relevant records to all residents of the United States and agencies under the Act at reasonable times and to provide for reimbursement of all costs incurred in extracting, reproducing and/or mailing such records.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of Limerick Township hereby repeals Resolution No. 98-18 and resolves that the attached Limerick Township Policy for Right-to-Know Law Requests is hereby adopted and shall become effective January 1, 2009.
