

LIMERICK TOWNSHIP
MS4 UPDATE- Year 3

- The Township's MS4 permit became effective on March 16, 2018. Year 3 of the permit ends on June 30, 2021.
- A Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) is required as part of the new permit. The PRP requires a 10% reduction in sediment in an unnamed tributary to Perkiomen Creek by August 31, 2024. The Township proposes to meet this requirement through a basin retrofit in Bradford Woods.
- Six (6) Minimum Control Measures are required to be met to be in compliance with the MS4 permit:
 - Public Education & Outreach
 - Public Involvement & Participation
 - Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination
 - Construction Site Runoff Control
 - Post-Construction Runoff Control
 - Pollution Prevention/Municipal Good Housekeeping
- Stormwater information is available on the Township's website. The Township has also partnered with the Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy for educational materials and outreach opportunities.
- All stormwater outfalls in the Township are required to be screened once before the permit expires in 2023.
