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2025 Transportation Improvements

The following is a list of **“tentative”** capital road improvement projects approved, funded, and scheduled for 2025. As always, we evaluate these road projects following each winter season, and our roads will be evaluated during the spring. As mentioned, this is a tentative list of improvements and may change due to weather, needs and budgets.

The Public Works Department will also be performing other types of road maintenance such as: line painting, roadside mowing, clearing sight lines, base repairs, roadside ditch work and sign maintenance, however; the following projects are noted as they may, at times, cause temporary delays or detours during the construction phases. The Department will make every effort to accommodate local traffic, however, for the safety of you and the workers on the road, please obey all work zone traffic control signs, flagmen directives, and marked detours. As a reminder, all fines are doubled in all Work Zone Traffic areas within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Allow some extra time in your daily commutes to avoid unnecessary frustration while transitioning through the work zones and detours. TENATIVE ROAD MAINTENANCE WORK:

- **Bituminous Surface Treatments:**

Pruss Hill – From Twp. Line to end w/fog.
Swamp Creek – From Twp. Line to end w/fog.
St. Andrews – From Limerick Center to end w/ fog.
Dusseldorf – From St. Andrews to end w/fog.
Paddington – From St. Andrews to end w/fog.
Gleneagles – From St. Andrews to St. Andrews end w/fog.
Longcross – From St. Andrews to St. Andrews end w/fog.

- **Ultra-Thin Wearing Course:**

Graterford Road – From Sunset Road to N. Limerick Road.

- **Storm Sewer Installations / Drainage Work:**

Various crossover pipe replacements
Longview Road – Replace storm pipe crossing @ Training Center.
Graterford Road – Crossover pipe replacements, from Sunset Road to N. Limerick
Railroad / Mill – Storm pipe replacements
Springford Road – Storm pipe culvert replacement
Various storm inlet repairs throughout the Township.

- **Contracted Milling and Paving:**

7th Ave. – From King Road to Twp. end – Cold Mill & Overlay
Galie Way – From King Road to 7th Ave. – Cold Mill & Overlay
Shannon Way – From 7th Ave. to Galie Way – Cold Mill & Overlay
Broadleaf – From Royersford to end – Cold Mill & Overlay
Willowwood – From Royersford to end – Cold Mill & Overlay
Rosewood Trail – From Main Street to end – Cold Mill & Overlay
Summerdale – From Main Street to Rosewood – Cold Mill & Overlay
Swamp Pike – One lane along new park site – Cold Mill & Overlay
Heffner Road – From Sunset Road – New paving at Twp. Line – Recycle and Overlay

Storm sewer installs for Royersford Road, Longview, Railroad
Limerick Community Park Extension - Ballfield work; drainage basin retro upgrade; new crosswalk

Other road projects that may take place on non-Township & State Roads:

**Lewis Road - storm sewer work
Ridge Pike - sewer line extensions
Game Farm Road - mill and re-paving
Paving sections on Linfield Trappe
Lightcap Road/Evergreen Road - utility installations**

Expect delays in these areas as well.

Note: All the projects listed are flexible and subject to change due to budget and/or weather conditions. Dates and times are "tentative schedules." Please continue to check our website for changes in road projects as well as roadwork notices.

Crews will also be performing line painting throughout the spring and summer. Please avoid driving on fresh paint. Crews will be performing right-of-way mowing, vegetation control and sight distance trimming as well.

All these projects will require the department to perform prep work. Base repairs will take place as well as some crack sealing in house. All the drainage updates will be done by Township forces ahead of the improvements. The department will also perform the finish work for Limerick Community Park extensions installing backstop, benches, re-seeding multi-purpose fields, baseball/softball fields. With these projects and our regular routine maintenance, the department will have a full workload for the season.

Annual street sweeping is scheduled to begin on or around the week of April 7th and should wrap up by April 26th, weather permitting. Please do not park on the streets from April 21st through April 25th during the time of 7am to 3pm if possible. Crews will not return to sweep areas where cars had been parked.

During the busy spring and summer months please obey all Work Zone Traffic signs, the crews are busy making the roads safe for all to travel.

NOTICE:

Limerick Township Public Works Department will be applying vegetation and weed control products within the Township curb line and right-of-ways. Products applied will include, but not limited to: Accord XRT II, Plateau, Esplanade 200 SC. These products will be applied to areas around signposts, Utility poles, guide rails, culverts, inlets, curbs, and sight lines within Township right of way.
