

# Mailboxes, Basketball Hoops & Fixed Objects

**R**esidents  
are  
responsible  
for clearing  
snow around  
mailboxes  
& fire  
hydrants.



**The Public Works Department is not responsible for clearing around mailboxes.**

It is also the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure the following:

- ❄️ The mailbox is installed and maintained to stand up to heavy snow and wind
- ❄️ The mailbox should be no closer than 8-inches from the face of curb or edge of the road.

**Snow Plow Damage to a Mailbox by Public Works Crews:**

- ❄️ If the mailbox is protruding into the road and is hit by a plow unit it is the responsibility of the homeowner to replace or repair.
- ❄️ If the mailbox is installed properly and is accidentally struck by a plow unit, the Township will replace the damaged parts of the mailbox and/or post, however the actual installation is the responsibility of the property owner.

**Basketball poles are often installed within the Township Right-of-Ways & extend into the roadway; these installations are unsafe and are illegal.**

These obstructions *must be removed*.

The Township is *not* responsible for damage to this obstruction. In fact, the property owner will be held liable for damage to our plow units caused by these obstructions.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation in removing this type of equipment from the roadway.
