

LIMERICK TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC MEETING RULES

To ensure that all residents have a fair opportunity to be heard in an orderly environment, the following rules of procedures must be followed.

- 1) Each speaker must be a resident or taxpayer of Limerick Township.
- 2) Each speaker will be limited to 2 minutes.
- 3) All comments must be courteous and not contain any offensive language.
- 4) Yelling, chanting and other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- 5) Questions must be directed at witnesses and not Board members or other speakers. If there are no witnesses, then each speaker must give public comment without interrogating anyone else in the room.
- 6) No signs will be permitted in the Township building. However, signs may be displayed outside the Township building.
- 7) Any disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- 8) The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors has the discretion to waive any of the above requirements.
- 9) Anyone not following these procedures will be asked to leave the Township building.
