Another holiday is upon us, and as we close out 2024, we move closer toward the celebration of Limerick's Tricentennial in 2026. So many have called Limerick home over the past 3 centuries and many more will do so in the coming years and decades.

Planning is ongoing for a special 300th celebration that will look back on all that Limerick has been, and the wonderful community we all enjoy now. Please save the date and read about the details of the 2026 celebration in the following pages of this newsletter.

We also celebrate the completion of the Community Park Expansion Project that brings to this community new amenities that will enhance the services of our

entire parks and recreation department, which includes: 2 tennis, 4 pickleball, and 2 bocce courts. Many have requested these features, and we are pleased that they are now available, along with new trail links, a ball field, and a multi-purpose athletic field.

Other enhancements to the Township's park system will be studied in future years to ensure they are in line with community desires and needs. One such improvement will involve the reconstruction of the Manderach Playground. This playground is the center feature of the entire Community Park and has hosted generations of children over the past 25 years. The wooden structure is approaching the end of its lifecycle; therefore, the Township will begin the planning and design process that will culminate in a modern, accessible playground that children will be able to enjoy for years to come. Our resident volunteer Parks and Recreation Committee will be at the forefront of the planning for this new playground; please watch for updates throughout 2025 on the progress of the design of the new playground, along with the proposed construction schedule.

The Limerick Community Park Expansion Project is complete!



On a beautiful, albeit windy Saturday, members from the community, public officials, and Township staff formally opened the newest addition of the community park. Board Supervisors, Patrick Morroney and Linda Irwin; Township Manager, Daniel Kerr; State Representative, Joe Ciresi; along with Township staff and residents, cut the 25-foot ribbon symbolizing the official opening of the new courts and trails.

This phase includes: four pickleball courts, two tennis courts, two bocce ball courts, ball fields, additional parking and more trail connectivity. Organized teams or tournament play must be registered and pay the appropriate fees through the Limerick Township Parks and Recreation Department. All other players do not need to reserve court time; please just follow the rules of common courtesy.




